

Tour de Mississauga Volunteer Marshals: Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q. Are we supposed to fill in any application form or any other form?

A. Please download the **Volunteer Marshal Permission Form / Waiver** and the **City Volunteer Participant Waiver** from the Tour de Mississauga website:

<http://www.mississaugacycling.ca/tour/marshals> and have your parent sign it if you are under 18 years old. Please e-mail: contact@mississaugacycling.ca to indicate your intention to volunteer, and we will e-mail any other forms or information you may require.

Q. After we complete the **Volunteer Forms / Waivers** where do we return them?

A. We prefer you bring the signed forms to us on the CHECK-IN DAY: **Saturday, Sept. 17 @ 10am – 2pm** at the Glass Pavilion attached to the Central Library. You need to receive your Marshal package, including the FREE Marshal T-shirt. Otherwise, bring your signed waivers with you on TOUR DAY (morning of **Sunday, September 18 @ 7:30 a.m.**) and give them to Don Stephens, who is the Marshal co-ordinator. If you do not bring your signed forms, you cannot be a Marshal. On TOUR DAY, meet at Mississauga Celebration Square at the “Check-In” table.

Q. Will there be Peel District School Board volunteer hour Activity Sheets there, or should I bring my own?

A. Please bring your own Activity Sheet. Don Stephens will sign them at the end of the Tour.

Q. My school requires online confirmation of the volunteer hours. Who is the MCAC leader?

A. Don Stephens is in charge of volunteer marshals for this event. He is the Vice-Chair of the Mississauga Cycling Advisory Committee (MCAC), which reports to City Council. Contact him at: contact@mississaugacycling.ca

Q. Will I need to bring a lunch?

A. Lunch is provided, but please bring a snack. Be sure to wear a hat and sun protection as well.

Q. Is a volunteering position guaranteed?

A. Yes! From 7:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on TOUR DAY: **Sunday Sept 18**. An extra half-hour will be awarded for coming to the CHECK-IN DAY to pick up your Marshal package.

Q. Is it possible to be notified of other volunteer opportunities in near future via e-mail?

A. Yes, you will be contacted for other cycling related events. To find other volunteer opportunities, go to MBC Volunteer www.volunteermbc.org

Q. Can I bring my friends along?

A. This is not possible. Once you have been placed at a location, you need to be focusing on your responsibilities and we don't have the capacity to transport more than the marshals we have scheduled. All marshals will be issued a FREE Tour volunteer T-shirt, and Tour riders will recognize you as such; having friends with you will not be helpful for riders looking to identify you.
